

WHAT IS THE ANGLE PROJECT?
The ANGLE Project is a consortium of 20 Partner institutions and 32 Associate institutions in Europe and in the ACP countries, coordinated by the Universidade do Porto and co-coordinated by the University of South Pacific.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Students, teachers and administrative staff from the ACP countries.

WHAT ARE THE ELIGIBILITY REQUISITES THAT APPLY TO ALL CANDIDATES?

- Must be nationals of one of the eligible ACP Countries
- Must have not benefited in the past from an Erasmus Mundus scholarship for the same type of mobility
- Must have not resided, lived or carried out their main activity (work, study, etc.) for more than 12 months (on the date of application) over the last five years in one European Country
- Must have sufficient knowledge of the tuition language of the host institution or of one of the languages currently spoken in the hosting country
